

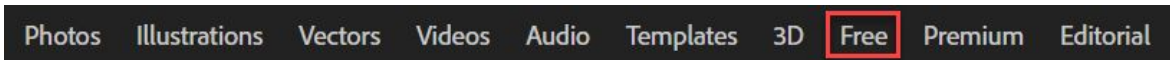
Adobe Stock - Access to Free Assets


Open Adobe Stock web page:

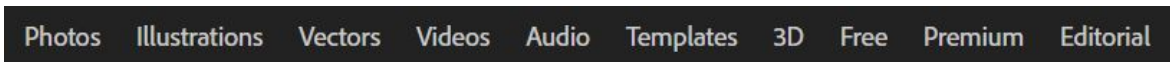
1. Open the **Adobe Creative Cloud** app on your desktop.
2. Select **Stock** under the **Resource Links** to access Adobe Stock.



Adobe has made a large number of Stock assets available **free of charge**. To access the free assets, go to the **top menu bar and select Free** to view the available free stock assets.



In addition, all **VCU purchased Adobe Stock assets** are royalty-free and may be used by any student, faculty and staff within the VCU community. These assets appear within the Stock Library with a blue Licensed badge  on the image. Search the Stock Library for a desired asset. If you wish to narrow the asset type, use the top menu bar and select one of the listed assets.

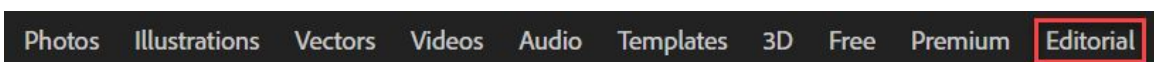


Note: Only authorized faculty and staff may purchase a non-licensed asset. Faculty and staff may request purchase access by contacting adobe@vcu.edu.

Editorial assets do have use restrictions.

Adobe defines **Editorial** as “Images and videos that are newsworthy, timely, and depict real people, events, places and products.”

Adobe usage **restrictions on Editorial** - “Content marked as "Editorial Use Only" is intended to illustrate stories about real people and events. Editorial content **MayNot** be used for commercial purposes, such as advertisements or resale products. You can view all of the terms of use at <https://stock.adobe.com/license-terms>.”



Download a Licensed Stock Asset

Stock assets purchased under the Adobe Enterprise Agreement may be used by any VCU Adobe licensed user.

- **Assets purchased by VCU** will display a **blue Licensed badge** on the displayed asset.
- Use the **Download icon** to download the asset **free** of charge.



Stock Asset Libraries

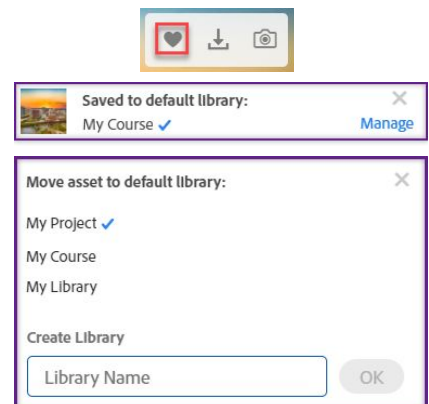
Only the 100GB Creative Cloud license entitlements are given access to downloading assets to **My Library** or the ability to create a special library. Using libraries will help you manage your assets.

Add Assets to a Library or create a new Library:

1. Go to the Stock asset you wish to save.
2. Roll over the asset until the menu appears and select the **heart icon** to save to the Library.
3. Click **Manage** to select the Library you wish to download and save the asset.

If a new Library is needed, use Create Library and click **OK**.

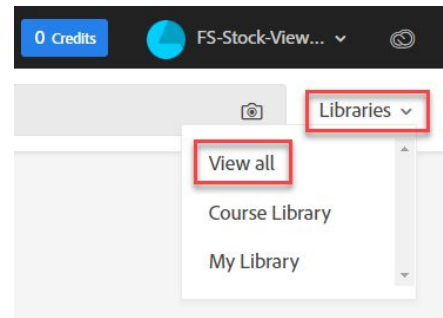
4. You may click the asset to open other options.



View assets in a Library:

1. Go to the **Libraries** drop list and select the desired library.
2. Select **All Libraries** to display all Libraries. This will provide you with a view of **all your stock asset libraries**.

Libraries may be created for courses or special projects.
